

The Dr. Peter Douglas Brown Graduate Studies Scholarship

Application Criteria:

This scholarship is open to all former graduates of Westgate Mennonite Collegiate who spent over three years at Westgate during their Junior High and High School years. It will be awarded on an annual basis to one successful candidate. The successful candidate must be currently enrolled in an accredited university working towards either an academic Masters degree or a PhD. Students enrolled in a professional program, such as medicine, business or law are not eligible at this time.

Applications will be accepted up until the end of May with the award being announced and dispersed prior to the beginning of the next school year in September.

To apply a candidate must submit a less than one page letter to Westgate outlining:

- 1) The school they are currently enrolled in
- 2) Their current area of study and research
- 3) The long term goals of this research
- 4) Where they see their educational pursuits taking them in the future

The letter of application must also briefly outline when they were students at Westgate and the year they graduated.

Accompanying the letter of application must be documentation from the school they are undertaking their graduate studies confirming the applicant's enrollment. The applicant's complete contact information must also be included.

The applications will be reviewed by a committee made up of the current principal of Westgate as well as Dr. Peter Douglas Brown. A decision will be made between these two parties as to who shall receive the scholarship.

The successful candidate must be willing to have their name published in the Westgate Perspective with a brief paragraph on their current studies.
