## WILLIAM LOEWEN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

This fund was established in 1987 to perpetuate the memory of William Loewen, one of one of the early board members of Westgate and a strong supporter of the school. He had been associated with the music business since the early days of Piano House, which later became known as Yamaha Canada.

This \$1000.00 scholarship (which may be divided into two shared \$500. awards) is intended to recognize a graduating student who has actively participated in the music program at Westgate and is pursuing a career in music following graduation. Note: if the award is being shared the second need not be in grade 12.

**<u>Eligibility</u>**: This award is intended for a student who has excelled in either the band or choir program and who is also involved in music outside of school (lessons, church choir, etc.) The applicant must also be pursuing education or significant involvement in music following graduation. Priority will be given to students entering full time music studies. Preference will be given to those in financial need.

<u>Selection</u>: Completed applications will be reviewed by the Westgate Awards Committee and a selection will be made after consultation with Mr. Walter Loewen. The scholarship will be presented to the recipient at the Awards Ceremony at the end of June.

**<u>Requirements</u>**: Students wishing to apply must fill out the attached application form which includes a summary of musical accomplishments and involvements.
